Let's go to Mammoth Lakes for a long-weekend get-away in the Sierras. Why drive to the mountains when you can catch the FVSC bus? Just kick back and relax. Bring your pals or make new friends. Three days to hit the slopes for skiing or snowboarding, right up 'til 3:30 on Sunday. Whether you're an expert or would like to learn – all abilities are welcome. Non-skiers can enjoy the town, shop the outlet stores or hang-out in one of the mountain lodges. For a change, catch the shuttle to historic Tamarack Lodge for snowshoeing, cross-country skiing or a naturalist tour around beautiful Twin Lakes. Even dog-sledding and snowmobiling can be arranged. We're staying just across from Canyon Lodge for convenient ski access. You can also catch the Blue Line shuttle or take the free gondola to the village.

- **Make checks payable to FOUNTAIN VALLEY SKI CLUB.** Please write **separate checks** for trip and membership dues. \$25 penalty will be charged for any check returned by your bank.
- **CANCELLATION POLICY: Once payment has been made there will be no refunds unless 1) you replace yourself with someone of the same gender 30 or more days before the trip date or 2) you can be replaced with someone from a waiting list.**

Bus will depart from the Garden Grove Elks Lodge, 11551 Trask Ave. at **5:00 PM sharp** on Thursday. Plan to **arrive at 4:15 PM** to load the bus. There is ample off-street parking. For those who wish to take along additional food, storage containers (marked for each condo) will be available at the bus so you can transport your provisions in the cargo bay. Bus will return to the Elks Lodge by approximately **11:00 PM** on Sunday.

Bus will be making one or more additional pick-up/drop-off stops in Los Angeles County.

An optional Friday night pizza + salad dinner will be offered for \$6 per person. Mammoth will be hosting the party, with dinner and dancing at Canyon Lodge Saturday night.
